

CONTEST RULES
(the “Official Rules”)

I WAKE UP WITH BT
(the “Contest”)

These Official Rules govern the Contest. By participating or attempting to participate in the Contest, you will be deemed to have read, understood, and agreed to be bound by these Official Rules.

1. WHO ARE THE SPONSORS?

The Contest is sponsored and administered by Rogers Communications Inc. or one of its subsidiaries or affiliates (“**Rogers**”), on behalf of Breakfast Television Toronto (the “**Station**”).

The following entity is a prize provider solely with respect to the Vacation Packages as described in Section 8 below: The Walt Disney (Canada) Ltd. (“**Prize Provider**”).

Rogers and any co-sponsors of the Contest are referred to collectively or individually as the “**Sponsors**”.

This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by or associated with any third-party social media or social networking service or site (each a “**Third Party Service**”), including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram and/or Twitter. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest should be directed to Rogers and not to any Third Party Service.

2. WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER?

To be eligible to enter this Contest, an individual must be:

- (a) a legal resident of the province of Ontario who has reached the age of majority as of the date of entry.
- (b) be legally able to travel to the United States of America and The Bahamas and have any and all necessary documentation as may be required for presentation to Canadian and/or international customs and airport personnel.

Employees, officers, directors, agents, and representatives of the Sponsors, Prize Provider or any of their respective parents, subsidiaries or affiliates, any prize suppliers, any and all other companies associated with the Contest, a household member of any of the individuals listed above, whether or not related or members of the immediate family (spouse, parent, child, sibling) of the individuals listed above are not eligible to enter.

3. WHEN DOES THE CONTEST START/END?

You may enter the Contest between 5:00 a.m. on March 22 and 7:55 p.m. on July 4th, 2022 (“**Entry Period**”). Should the Vacation Packages described in Section 8 below not have been awarded by July 4, 2022, the Entry Period will be extended until all Vacation Packages are awarded as described in these Official Rules. All times referenced in these Official Rules are Eastern Times.

4. HOW DO I ENTER THE CONTEST?

No purchase is necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using the method of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.

First, go to <https://www.breakfasttelevision.ca/contests/i-wake-up-with-bt/> (the “**Contest Website**”) during the Entry Period, click on the Contest banners, buttons or links to access the online entry form for the Contest and complete and submit the online entry form as instructed during the Entry Period.

Beginning at the start of the Entry Period and every weekday (Monday through Friday) thereafter but excluding Good Friday, Victoria Day, and Canada Day (each a “**Weekday**”) during the Entry Period, the Station will hold a random draw (“**Weekday Draw**”) from all eligible online entries received up until the draw. Non-selected entries will be carried forward to the next Weekday Draw.

Once you have submitted your online entry form, watch Breakfast Television Toronto at approximately 8:00 AM each Weekday. If you are the selected entrant in the Weekday Draw, wait for a call from the Station following the Contest cue “**I Wake Up with BT!**”. The Station will make a maximum of one (1) attempt to call the selected entrant live on air.

The selected entrant must answer their phone within 4 rings when called and must correctly say “**I Wake Up with BT!**” to be deemed the potential winner.

Until June 28, 2022, potential winners will be eligible to win the Cash Prize available on that Weekday (refer to Section 8 below). As of June 29, 2022 three (3) potential winners will be eligible to win the Cash Prize available for that Weekday and one (1) Vacation Package as described in Section 8.

If the telephone line is dead when answered, or no audible response is heard, or no one responds after four rings, the Station reserves the right to disqualify the selected entrant and hold another Weekday Draw from the remaining pool of eligible entries on that Weekday.

If the Station is unable to contact any selected entrant as set out above, or if the selected entrant does not say “**I Wake Up with BT!**” when answering the phone, the selected entrant will be disqualified and there will be no potential winner for that Weekday.

The Station’s online stream may be a delayed stream of the Station’s television signal and may vary depending on your computer’s memory capacity and the speed of your Internet connection. For that reason, it is recommended that viewers watch the Station in “real time” by turning on an actual television.

5. HOW MANY TIMES MAY I ENTER THE CONTEST?

There is a limit of one online entry per person per person/email address. By way of illustration, if two or more otherwise eligible individuals share a single email address, only one of them may enter the Contest; and, if an eligible individual has multiple email addresses, they may only enter the Contest once in respect of only one of those email addresses. In the case of multiple entries, only the first eligible entry will be considered.

In the case of multiple entries into a contest with defined entry limitations, only the first eligible entry will be considered.

6. COULD MY ENTRY BE REFUSED OR REJECTED?

Your entry could be refused or rejected if:

- (a) you attempt to enter the Contest in a fashion not authorized by these Official Rules;
- (b) your entry contains false or misleading information, or is late, falsified, illegible, damaged or incomplete or otherwise irregular;
- (c) your entry is submitted using robotic, automated, programmed, or other illicit means; or
- (d) your entry is not in compliance with these Official Rules.

The Sponsors reserve the right to refuse any entry for any other reason as they may determine.

7. WHAT ARE THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY?

By entering the Contest:

- (a) you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the Sponsors, which decisions are final, binding and conclusive;
- (b) you represent and warrant that: (i) your entry, including any material comprising your entry (e.g. name, user name, profile picture, etc., as applicable) and any material submitted with your entry (e.g. photograph, video, written submission, or other form of submission, as applicable) (all such material, collectively, the “**Entry Material**”) is original to you, (ii) you have all necessary rights in and to your Entry Material to enter the Contest, including the consent of any third parties whose personal information is included in your Entry Material, and (iii) your Entry Material and, if a selected entrant in a Weekday Draw or Finalist, any statements made by you during your on air telephone call or zoom appearance (as applicable), does not contain, depict, include or involve content that is, or could reasonably be considered to be, inappropriate, unsuitable or offensive, as determined by the Sponsors;
- (c) you understand and agree that your entry, including your Entry Material, will not be returned to you and may be moderated or edited by Rogers as it deems appropriate;
- (d) you grant to the Sponsors the irrevocable right to use your Entry Material in any media worldwide and for any purpose related to the Contest (or any similar contest), including the right to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, translate, or create derivative works from, your Entry Material without notification, compensation or additional consideration to you;
- (e) you waive all claims of moral rights in any use of your Entry Material by Rogers pursuant to the rights granted in these Official Rules; and
- (f) you waive and forever discharge the Sponsors, and Prize Provider, their respective parents, affiliates, and subsidiaries, any other companies associated with the Contest, and all of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, dealers, licensees, successors and assigns, as well as any Third Party Services, (collectively, the “**Releasees**”), and agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of the Releasees, from and against any and all claims, damages or liability, including any costs or losses related to personal injury, death, damage to or loss or destruction of property, arising out of, or in any way related to, (i) your participation in the Contest, (ii) the awarding, receipt, possession, use or misuse of any prize, in whole or in part, including participating in travel or any activity related to the prize, (iii) the use of any Entry Material or Publicity Material (defined below) in accordance with the rights granted in these Official Rules, or (iv) any breach of these Official Rules.

8. WHAT ARE THE CONTEST PRIZES?

(a) CASH PRIZES

There are up to 75 (seventy-five) Cash Prizes available to be won in the Contest, each consisting of a minimum of one-thousand dollars (CDN \$1,000), to be awarded by cheque in the name of the winner (cheques to be issued within 6 weeks of being confirmed a winner).

If a Cash Prize is not won on a given Weekday, the Cash Prize will increase by an incremental one-thousand dollars (CDN \$1,000) the following Weekday and so forth and so on, until a selected entrant is deemed the potential winner of that Cash Prize.

(b) VACATION PACKAGES

There are three (3) prizes (each, a “**Vacation Package**”; together, “**Vacation Packages**”) available to be won in the Contest, each consisting of a 4-night Bahamian *Disney Cruise Line* vacation for the winner and up to three (3) guests (each a “**Guest**”; collectively “**Guests**”; and, together with the Winner, the “**Group**”) aboard the *Disney Wish* leaving from Port Canaveral, Florida; and, one (1) 1-night stay at the *Walt Disney World* Resort in Florida prior to the cruise. Each Vacation Package will consist of the following:

Each 4-Night Bahamian Cruise shall consist of the following:

- Up to four (4) round-trip coach airfares between the major gateway airport closest to the winner’s residence in Canada (the “**Departure Airport**”) and the Orlando International Airport (the “**Arrival Airport**”) in Orlando, FL;

- A 4-Night Bahamian Cruise aboard the *Disney Wish* for up to four (4) persons and includes:
 - One (1) stateroom aboard the *Disney Wish* (location/category at the discretion of *Disney Cruise Line*). Maximum occupancy for four (4) people.
 - All meals onboard the *Disney Wish* (except *Palo Steakhouse* and *Enchanté Fine Dining*).
 - Onboard gratuities for up to four (4) persons (for stateroom host/hostess, dining room server, assistant server and head server).
 - Taxes, Fees and Port Expenses (as defined on the *Disney Cruise Line* website).
- Round trip ground transportation for up to four (4) persons from the *Walt Disney World* Resort to Port Canaveral, FL, and from Port Canaveral, FL to the Orlando International Airport.

Each *Walt Disney World* Resort pre-cruise one (1)-night stay shall consist of the following:

- One (1) standard room at a *Walt Disney World* Resort Hotel (location/category at the discretion of Disney), maximum occupancy four (4) people, for one (1) night prior to Group's scheduled departure aboard the *Disney Wish*.
- Up to four (4) 1-Day Theme Park Tickets with *Park Hopper* Option.
- One (1) Disney Gift Card in the amount of three hundred U.S. dollars (USD\$300.00) for the Winner.
- Transportation for up to four (4) passengers from the Orlando International Airport to the *Walt Disney World* Resort.

Please note:

Items not included as part of the Vacation Package, which are the responsibility of the winner, include: shore excursions; travel and medical insurance; nursery charges; laundry service; spa treatments; alcoholic beverages; local and long distance telephone calls; ship to shore communications including internet; merchandise and souvenirs; incidental expenses; additional tips and gratuities not specifically set forth above; income and other taxes; transportation between winner's home and Departure Airport; airline baggage fees; parking fees; and all other costs and expenses not otherwise mentioned herein.

Each Vacation Package is valued at approximately twelve thousand, eight hundred twenty-six and 56/100 Canadian dollars (CDN \$12,826.56), which includes Taxes, Fees and Port Expenses (as defined on the *Disney Cruise Line* website). The actual value of each Vacation Package may vary depending on point of departure, seasonal fluctuations of hotel rates and airfares, and fluctuations in the currency exchange rates for U.S. Dollars. Any difference between the approximate retail value and the actual cost of any Vacation Package will not be awarded.

The following terms and conditions apply to any Vacation Package awarded in this Contest:

- (i) Vacation Package must be booked at least 45 days prior to the intended travel dates and must be taken prior to **November 1, 2023** aboard the *Disney Wish* (at the discretion of *Disney Cruise Line*). Please go to www.disneycruise.com to view available sail dates.
 - **Travel dates between: November 1, 2022 – November 1, 2023**
 - Block out dates: 11/21/2022; 12/19/2022; 12/26/2022; 2/20/2023; 3/13/2023; 3/20/2023; 04/04/2023; 05/29/2023 (Block out dates are at the discretion of *Disney Cruise Line* and are subject to change).
 - Pre-cruise 1-night stay at *Walt Disney World* Resort available for use only on the night prior to Group's scheduled departure aboard the *Disney Wish*.
- (ii) Vacation Package is for the Winner and up to three (3) guests of the Winner's choosing. The Group must travel together on the same itinerary, and air transportation must be round-trip from/to the same Departure Airport/Arrival Airport, as chosen by Prize Provider. Once selected by the

Winner, Guests cannot be changed without the express consent of Prize Provider, which may be withheld for any reason.

(iii) Minors under the age of 18 not traveling with a parent or legal guardian must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21 in the same stateroom. The parent or guardian of any minor not traveling with a parent or guardian must appoint an adult to have custody and control over their minor and to contract on their behalf in connection with the Vacation Package. An appointment form will be included in the document package and must be signed by parent or legal guardian prior to embarkation at the *Disney Cruise Line* terminal.

(iv) Vacation Package fulfillment and travel are subject to certain restrictions, air travel/flight availability, and certain hotel/room availability. The Vacation Package must be booked through a travel agent as designated by Prize Provider at least forty-five (45) days prior to arrival. Block out dates apply. No extensions will be granted. Certain travel and lodging restrictions apply including airline carrier's regulations and conditions. Airline tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable, and are not valid for upgrades. Sponsors and Prize Provider are not liable for any expenses incurred as a consequence of flight cancellation/delay.

(v) Sponsors shall have no responsibility or liability for cancellations, delays, or any other change by any company or person providing any element of the Vacation Package due to reasons beyond Sponsors' control, and are not responsible or liable for any expenses incurred as a consequence thereof. Guests, if any, may be required to execute and return releases of liability and, where legal, publicity releases (collectively, "**Guest Documents**"), which must be returned with the verification documents requested of Winner, or Guest portion of the Vacation Package will be forfeited.

(vi) Any damaged, lost or stolen theme park tickets, travel vouchers or gift cards will not be replaced. Gift cards are not redeemable or exchangeable for cash (except as required by law) and are subject to all terms and conditions of use as established by issuer.

(vii) Vacation Package may not be sold, traded, transferred, refunded, commissioned or redeemed for cash value.

(viii) Vacation Package elements may not be substituted and vacation is non-commissionable.

(ix) Actual final retail value of Vacation Package may vary depending on point of departure and fluctuations of hotel rates and airfares. Any difference between the approximate retail value and the actual cost of the/each Vacation Package will not be awarded.

(x) If the actual value of the Vacation Package is less than stated ARV, the difference will not be awarded. All expenses not specifically provided for herein, including parking and concessions (if applicable), are the Winner's sole responsibility. Some restrictions may apply.

(xi) Group is responsible for providing proper citizenship documentation to travel which may include passports, valid alien registration card and/or necessary visas. Those without proper citizenship documentation will be denied boarding. It is the Guests' responsibility to check with their travel agent, government agencies, embassies or consulates prior to their vacation to ensure that they have proper citizenship documentation. Guests of all ages are strongly encouraged to obtain passports. Citizens of Canada can also visit the Passport Canada website for detailed information on the mandatory passport requirements <http://www.passportcanada.gc.ca/>. Winner and his/her Guests are solely responsible for determining and obtaining all necessary travel documents and other travel requirements. No changes will be made to travel details once any portion of travel arrangements has been made.

(xii) The Winner and his/her Guests will be required to execute a liability/publicity/COVID-19 release form prior to booking of any travel. Failure to return the executed release form within the specified time period will result in forfeiture of the Vacation Package. By accepting the Vacation Package, each Winner understands and agrees that he/she is responsible for any actions, claims or liabilities of any of his/her Guests, and that Prize Provider has the right, in its sole discretion, to refuse entry to or remove any attendee from the *Disney Wish* or the *Walt Disney World Resort* at any time if such attendee's behavior at any point is disruptive or may or does cause damage to person, property or the reputation of Prize Provider or otherwise violates the rules or policies of the *Disney Wish* or the *Walt Disney World Resort*.

(xiii) There may be specific instructions and requirements for all visitors to the Bahamas, which may include mandated quarantine or pre-travel testing. The Winner and his/her Guests are solely responsible at their own cost for staying updated on and complying with any of the latest

advisories, restrictions and travel alerts that may be in place for travel to the Bahamas leading up to the planned stay. Travel requirements subject to change.

(xiv) Prize Provider, its parent, subsidiary, related and affiliated companies and each of their respective officers, directors employees and agents shall be released and discharged by winner and guests from any and all legal claims, losses injuries, demands, damages, actions, and /or causes of actions which arise out of and/or in any way relate to the Vacation Package, the receipt, use and/or enjoyment of the Vacation Package, any prize related activity and/or the Promotions. In the event there is a discrepancy or inconsistency between disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest promotional materials and the terms and conditions of the official rules, the official rules shall prevail and govern.

(xv) All elements of the Vacation Package (including, without limitation, the theme park tickets) must be used by the Group on the same dates during the redemption of the Vacation Package. Any portion of the Vacation Package not accepted or used by winner will be forfeited.

(xvi) Theme parks, attractions and other offerings subject to availability, closures and change or cancellation without notice or liability. Park admission, offerings and ticket options are not guaranteed. Prize Provider reserves the right to cancel any offering.

(xvii) **Theme park tickets must be used only between November 1, 2022 and November 1, 2023.** Terms and conditions as set forth herein and on the theme park tickets shall apply. To enter a theme park, both a park reservation and valid ticket for the same theme park on the same date are required. Reservations can be made using the Disney Park Pass system. Reservations are subject to availability and are not guaranteed until a reservation is finalized. A park reservation must be made for each day of entry. The *Park Hopper* Option includes same-day admission to more than one theme park on each day of your ticket. You must make a park reservation via the Disney Park Pass reservation system for the first theme park you plan to visit. After entering that first theme park, you will be able to visit the next theme park starting at 2:00 PM until each theme park's regularly scheduled closure. The ability to visit a theme park is subject to the theme park's capacity limitations. At this time, a park reservation is not required after the first theme park, however, reservation requires are subject to the change.

(xviii) A winner may not charge any Guest for participating in the Vacation Package. The Vacation Package is awarded "as is" with no warranty or guarantee, expressed or implied, being provided by Sponsors or Prize Provider.

(xix) The winner will not receive compensation for any element(s) of the Vacation Package (including, without limitation, theme park tickets) that any participant(s) is unable to use for any reason, and such unused portion(s) of the Vacation Package will be forfeited.

(xx) If the winner chooses to bring less than the allotted number of Guests, the Vacation Package will be awarded in increments suitable for the actual number of participants with no substitute prize or compensation provided to the winner.

(xxi) Federal, provincial, state and local taxes relating to the prize are the responsibility of the winner.

(xxii) All disputes arising out of or relating to any prize provided by Prize Provider shall be resolved by applying the laws of Florida, without regard to conflict of law rules, and shall be solely and exclusively brought in state or federal courts within Orange County, Florida. Such claims shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and all such claims shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event to include attorneys' fees.

(xxiii) ***Walt Disney World Resort has taken enhanced health and safety measures. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. Before visiting, each Guest should visit disneyworld.disney.go.com/en_CA/experience-updates/ to view important information about park reopening, reservations, limitations on benefits, features, experiences and offerings, new safety measures and other information.***

9. ARE THERE ANY PRIZE CONDITIONS?

All prize particulars will be determined by the Sponsors in their sole discretion. In addition to any prize conditions provided elsewhere in these Official Rules, any prize awarded in the Contest is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Except for gift cards, vouchers or cash prizes, the prize value in these Official Rules is approximate only. You will not be compensated if actual prize value is lower than the value quoted in these Official Rules;
- (b) The Sponsors and Prize Provider reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize, in whole or in part, with a prize or prize component of equal or greater value if the prize or any component thereof cannot be awarded for any reason;
- (c) The prize must be accepted as awarded and may not be transferred or resold, unless otherwise determined by the Sponsors and Prize Provider. The prize may not be exactly as advertised. The prize is provided “as is” without representation or warranty of any kind by the Sponsors or other Releasees;
- (d) Any unused portion of the prize, once awarded, will be deemed forfeited. The prize will not be replaced if lost, destroyed, mutilated or stolen;
- (e) The Releasees are not responsible for any delay or postponement, for any reason, of any aspect of the prize. Neither the confirmed winner nor any other person or entity will be compensated in the event of such delay or postponement;
- (f) manufacturer’s standard warranty, if any, applies to the prize;
- (g) Prize winner is solely responsible for reading and following all instructions, directions for use and warnings that are associated with each component of the applicable prize; and,
- (h) None of the Releasees makes any representation or offers any warranty, express or implied, as to the quality or fitness of the prize awarded in connection with the Contest. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the confirmed winner understands and acknowledges that he or she may not seek reimbursement or pursue any legal or equitable remedy from either the Sponsor or any of the Releasees should the prize fail to be fit for its purpose or is in any way unsatisfactory. For greater certainty and the avoidance of any doubt, by accepting the prize, the confirmed winner agrees to waive all recourse against the Releasees if the prize or a component thereof does not prove satisfactory, either in whole or in part.

10. ARE THERE ANY COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS?

In addition to any conditions provided elsewhere in these Official Rules, your entry in this Contest and any prize awarded may be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) You agree to comply with all applicable orders, directives, guidelines, COVID-19 procedures, COVID-19 related bylaws, and public health and safety regulations issued by federal, provincial and municipal authorities. Such guidelines and bylaws include without limitation, vaccination, quarantine, requirements related to hand sanitation, self-isolation, social and physical distancing, and use of face coverings as may be applicable.
- (b) as may be applicable, potential winner and any guest(s) of the winner, may be required to complete and pass a COVID-19 questionnaire, provide proof of full vaccination (Covid-19 vaccine series at to be completed at least 14 days before prize fulfilment) and provide proof COVID-19 testing result(s) (i.e. PCR or Antigen).

Due to present circumstances around COVID-19, if any of the prizes awarded in this Contest include namely but not limited to, tickets to concerts/shows, a meet and greet, an invitation to attend an event in person (“**Event(s)**”), the Events are subject to change. Venues and event organizers do implement safety requirements which you will need to accept and comply with in order to attend an Event. Sponsors assumes no liability for denied entry for any reason or for the cancellation, postponement or rescheduling of an Event. The winner and any guest(s) of the winner assume full liability for any risks incurred before, during and after the Event. Please check with the venue, event organizer or ticket provider for information prior to attending an Event.

11. HOW CAN A POTENTIAL WINNER BECOME A WINNER?

Before being declared a winner, a selected entrant must:

- (a) correctly answer, without assistance, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question to be administered by the Sponsors;
- (b) be in compliance with these Official Rules;
- (c) sign and return, within any designated time period, a release of liability and consent to publicity form (the “**Release Form**”) and any other documentation as reasonably required. The Sponsors may require winner’s guest(s) to sign and return, within any designated time period, a Release Form and any other documentation as reasonably required, as a pre-condition to participation in the prize. In the event any guest is a minor, the parent or legal guardian of the guest will be required to sign and return such paperwork on behalf of the minor guest; and
- (d) at the request of the Sponsors, provide proof of identification to confirm eligibility or to claim a prize, or provide proof that they are the authorized account holder of any account associated with the selected entry.

12. WHAT ARE THE ODDS OF WINNING A PRIZE?

The odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received in a Weekday Draw, on the capacity of the Station to contact a selected entrant and on the capacity of selected entrant to answer the call within four rings and to state the phrase “I WAKE UP WITH BT”.

13. HOW DO I CLAIM A PRIZE?

Once a potential winner is confirmed as a winner, prize distribution will be promptly coordinated. Except as otherwise indicated by the Sponsors, a winner must personally take delivery of the prize as instructed within sixty (60) days of being notified that such prize is available or within such other time period as may reasonably be advised. If a winner fails to take delivery of the prize as instructed, the prize will be deemed forfeited.

14. WILL I APPEAR IN ANY PUBLICITY IF I AM A WINNER?

If you are a winner, the Sponsors may require you to appear in publicity related to the Contest or to any similar contest. By accepting a prize you:

- (a) grant to the Sponsors the irrevocable right to record, photograph or otherwise capture or document you, your likeness, your voice, or any statements you make regarding the Contest or the prize, by any available means;
